CLEVELAND CEMETARY

The Cleveland Cemetery is located northeast behind the Cleveland School with a fence.

- 1. John Stevenson, a civil war veteran, died after 1928; spouse Sara Stevenson (Emma Friede's Grandfather) has a big Stone. (Log cabin in Cleveland home was the home of John and Sarah.)
- 2. Sarah F. Stevenson, nicknamed Sal, date of birth: Nov 27, 1847 in Missouri. Date of death: Nov. 17, 1928. Granddaughter Emma Friede retells memories that Sarah hadn't been feeling good, went down to People's Creek to get water to wash clothes; she fell in with her long dress, her husband could not get her out and she drowned. (Two heads stones: SARAH 1847-1928 & two metal markers on the ground.)
- 3. Thomas J. Stevenson, age 61, pioneer resident of the Cleveland Community, died Monday at a Havre hospital of heart ailment. Last rites were conducted by Fr. M.J. O'Sullivan. Burial was at Cleveland next to his father, John Stevenson. For many years, Mr. Stevenson had lived in the Cleveland area and also had worked in Chinook and the local community. He was a laborer. Surviving are his widow and several children. His wife was Rose Stevenson and Emma Friede was Rose Stevenson and Emma Friede was a daughter. (*Chinook Opinion* article dated Nov. 23, 1939.) No stones for Tom or wife, Rose.
- 4. Rose Stevenson, 57 years old (church records say 54), died Feb. 1, 1964; burial was Feb. 3, 1964.
- 5. Melvina Stevenson, female child, of Tom and Rose Stevenson, drowned. No stone.
- 6. Gus Stevenson, a school boy, almost 13, born April 25, 1915 to Tom and Rose Stevenson; froze to death Feb. 12, 1928. Emma Friede's brother. No stone.
- 7. Death Record Index #259 dated April 10, 1914: Paul McCaul, single, age 73 yrs, 6 mos, 21 days, formerly from Scotland; Date of death April 10, 1914 at Cleveland. Informant: Nels B. Gooo.
- 8. Death Record Index #318 dated May 29, 1916, Paul Gardipee; date of death May 28, 1916 at Cleveland. Informant Joseph Gardipee.
- 9. Death Record Index #792 dated Oct. 7, 1925: Wallenmeir Infant, female; Date of birth: Sept. 9, 1925 and Date of death: Sept. 9, 1925. Informant: Herman Wallenmeir of Cleveland.

- 11. Marjorie Rose Stevenson, infant.
- 12. Victor Clare Vers born April 5, 1929 died June 2, 1930 (1 yr 2 mos). Cleveland informant: Mrs. Chas Vers.
