

HOLLANDVILLE CHURCH AND CEMETERY

Starting at the corner stone or point constituting and being the NE corner of Sec 19, T34N, R20E, thence going in a westerly direction along the section line, dividing north and south Sec 18 and Sec 19 respectively, until a point 330 feet west of starting point is reached, thence going due south for one quarter of a mile, thence going due east for a distance of 330 feet, and thence going due north along the section line, dividing west and east Sec 19 and Sec 20 respectively, to place or point of starting, all of said land consisting of 10 acres more or less, situate, lying and being in the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec 19, T34N, R20E of the Montana Meridian. This land was donated by Emil Goessens Mar 20, 1916. The deed made out to the Roman Catholic Bishop of Great Falls, Corporation Sole, Great Falls, Montana, dated Dec 23, 1916.

Hollandville Cemetery is located 10 miles north on the Bagan Road, on the left side of the road behind St. Joseph's Church at Hollandville, blessed on April 30, 1916. Just across the Bagan Road east of the church the Hollandville School was built.
